#### **History of the founders of GCAP**

Randy and Rachel Williams started their life together in Hereford, TX back in the 70's. They started dating right after high school and married July 15, 1978. Randy's love of building and driving muscle cars became a passion that followed their whole family in the years to come. They raised 4 wonderful children, Jeremy Williams, who's the Directing Manager at GCAP, Emilee Bless who helps with her husband's body shop in Lakin KS, Amanda Gosch who is a safety manager at an energy gas plant in Lakin KS, and Jacob Williams who works in the Oklahoma City area as a financial advisor at a bank.

They both worked hard all their lives to provide a better living for their family. Rachel worked in the banking industry and Randy worked in food processing maintenance. Then they formed a commercial and Industrial contracting business which was very successful for over a decade and then sold in 1995. From there Randy began employment at a DOE site that was in charge of the United States weapon programs. He worked in many different aspects of the assembly and disassembly. After a few years, he resigned and returned to his specialized field of refrigeration in Guymon, OK working for Seaboard's farm hog processing plant as a Maintenance Manager/Engineer over the facility. They produced over 20,000 hogs a day at this facility and had over 150 mechanics on his team. After two years he was asked to move to Garden City, KS to help with the new Ammonia Training Facility that the community college was developing. So in March of 2000 he started his training career at the college.

The industrial program, at the community college was soon known all across the United States as the premier course to take for industrial refrigeration. Randy fell into the training as a natural, and understood the desperate need for quality training in this field. When the college lost their leadership and vision that was guiding the industrial program, Mr. and Mrs. Williams assembled investors and Randy resigned in 2003 from the college, and started what we know today as Garden City Ammonia Program (GCAP). They purchased the new 15,000 square foot, Harley Davidson building at 2405 East Fulton Plz. in Garden City, KS which became the starting point that changed the industry. In the beginning, they started with only 3 companies and now over 850 companies use GCAP which provide Industrial Refrigeration (both English and Spanish), Boiler Safety, CO2 Refrigeration, Process Safety Management and Risk Management training. Today GCAP has expanded to over 50,000 square feet at their training facility and have over 22 staff members.

Jeremy was born and raised in Hereford, Texas and graduated high school from Guymon, Oklahoma. Growing up his father Randy Williams owned his own contractor company, servicing and installing industrial/commercial refrigeration systems.
